Baptisms are not held during the season of Lent unless there are compelling circumstances. If permitted, baptisms during Lent will be done privately. Baptisms during Mass are not held on Christmas, Easter Sunday or Holy Days of Obligation. Baptisms are not celebrated also on Thanksgiving Day, New Year's Eve or New Year's Day, 4th of July or most national holidays.
