What has been done with our gifts in Malawi

1. Three houses done for the teachers and head Master (principle)
2. A School library is also done
3. School Books for students have been purchased
4. Church construction at St. Francis and St. Monica
5. The first student that finished school there was able to go to college! (student name is Yamikani and he has one year left of college.)

Father Ernest has done so much with our gifts. The church is the center of the community and has built a great team of love and caring throughout the village. He also helped the local village out with some special needs. Your gifts have built a great community with both helping each other out. Father Ernest was also helping out other churches in the area and now he has been moved to St. Kizito church. The new church has many issues and problems

1. No electric; a generator is needed badly
2. Roofs are leaking in Elementary school, church, rectory and there are damages inside all of these buildings. Rainy season has just begun also
3. There is no secondary (7-12 grades) school and kids have to walk a distance (if they go) to get to one.
4. No school books and supplies etc.

As you can see, the Bishop put Father Ernest in a place where he can help. With our gifts we are blessing and changing young students' lives in Malawi.
